Senate Committees:

- o CSS → Met Tuesday, October 24th
 - Appointed Student Co-Chair for the Committee
 - Received S2 budget presentation; asked to receive more information regarding a clear-cut breakdown of where money goes in Student Services
 - Executive Director's report → Health and Wellness Strategy was brought to P7, and a revised strategy will be coming out on Friday
 - Student Services is looking at how to make better use of students' time spent in service areas (outlets in waiting rooms, for example)
 - Reaching out to student associations to try and get consultation
 - Will be setting up two 2-hour "visioning" processes
 - Renovations coming next summer
 - Results of the Audit will soon be releasing a report of the internal audit and steps that will be taken to address issues found in Student Services
