- Will soon be undertaking approx. 2 year-long review of University Student Assessment Policy, given development of 5 guiding principles
 - Commitment to healthy teaching and learning environments
 - Assessment practices uphold high academic standards
 - Assessment practices are pedagogically sound
 - Faculty receive support to develop effective and meaningful assessment and feedback strategies that are sustainable
 - Assessment practices allow for valid and reliable judgements about individual student performance
- Will continue promoting Enhanced Educational Opportunities (EEO) grants out of SSAO
 - Piloted last year, awarded around \$345K over 105 disbursements
 - Cover direct or ancillary costs of extra-curricular educational/career-advancing opportunities
